

How to make a bird suet treat

Ingredients: 1 lb of suet
 ½ a cup of bird seed
 ½ a cup of nuts
 ½ a cup of assorted fruit
 Coconut shells or old plastic tubs

Instructions: **1)** Put the suet in a saucepan. On a low-medium heat, slowly warm the suet up until it has melted.
 2) Once the suet has melted, gradually add all the other ingredients while stirring.
 3) In your feeder, make a small hole and put a piece of string through it, so that you can hang it up. This could be an old ice cream tub, or similar plastic tub, or one half of a coconut shell.
 4) Once all the ingredients have been added, pour the mixture into your feeder.
 5) Once the mixture has been poured into the feeder, leave it in the fridge overnight. This will set the suet, and make it ready to hang up.
 6) Hang your feeder from a tree branch or other place where birds can reach it. Make sure to keep the feeder out of reach of cats.
